We received an email from the State of Michigan on 12/2 stating that the program timeline has been revised. Here is the email we received:

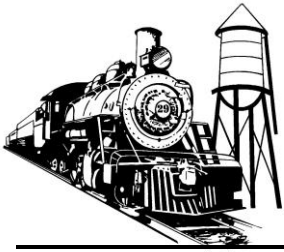
